Executive Summary: Fighting Chance Billingham Boxing Club has been set up by a team of volunteers. The clubs aims are to deter young people from engaging in anti-social behaviour in and around Billingham. They provide a base for young people to get them off the streets to exercise, learn new skills and socialise. The Club have recently moved into their own premises in Billingham town centre after previously renting space from other gyms. The Club have requested funding from the PCC to purchase equipment for the gym such as weights and floor matting. This initiative supports the PCC's objectives of Securing the Future of our Communities and Tackling Offending and Re-offending.


