Executive Summary: Redcar Beacons is a 'Street Angels' project and is part of the Christian Nightlife Initiative network. The Beacons are a local community group reliant upon volunteers. The project provides a caring presence in Redcar Town Centre on Friday and/or Saturday nights between 10pm and 3am, during the night time economy period when members of the public may become vulnerable and in need of help. The group have applied for funding from the Police Property Act Fund to purchase 20 coats for volunteer use and a contribution towards admin costs which includes a mobile phone. This funding supports the PCC's objective of Working Together to Make Cleveland Safer.
