I am sending this request under the Freedom of Information Act to ask for the following information:

- 1. Please could you tell how much money the PCC has spent on crime and disorder reduction grants.
- 2. Could you break this down by financial year, for this year and the past 3 calendar years, and what organizations the money went to.
- 3. Please could you tell how much money the PCC has spent on crime his crime prevention funding?
- 4. Could you break this down by financial year, for this year and the past 3 calendar years, and what organizations the money went to.

This request has been handled under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

Regarding your request I can now inform you that I have completed my enquiries and that my reply on behalf of the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner for Cleveland is as follows.

I can confirm that the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner for Cleveland does hold this information.

However I am refusing your request under s21 of the FOIA as the information is reasonably accessible by other means.

The purpose of the section 21 exemption is to ensure that there is no right of access to information via FOIA if it is available to the applicant by another route.
