Shop Wise Project			
Executive Summary:			
The Shop Wise Project is an initiative developed by Northumbria Coalition Against Crime (NCAC) incorporating the North East Retail Crime Partnership and Youth & Community Programmes which is aimed at engaging young people on the subject of retail crime. NCAC have requested funding to enable 30 sessions to be delivered reaching approximately 750 pupils in schools in Redcar and Cleveland and Middlesbrough. To enable to session to have more impact the sessions are delivered by a retailer and a NCAC facilitator. The retailers gain specific training from NCAC prior to co facilitating sessions.			
The Shop Wise Project supports the PCCs priority of diverting people from offending, with a focus on rehabilitation and the prevention of reoffending.
