The PCC would also like to understand how Cleveland Police compares with its most similar forces (MSFs) and nationally in respect of those crime rates.

The PCC would like information on what the Force strategy is in respect of improving outcome rates and reducing crime.

The PCC would like high level data on how much information is received from Crimestoppers and how much of that information goes on to provide a successful outcome, If it is possible to compare this information with MSFs and nationally that would be useful.
