**Title:**

Funding - Training for Cleveland Mountain Rescue

**Executive Summary:**

As a registered charity (252905) Cleveland Mountain Rescue (CMR) provides an emergency search and rescue service and a community support service for local people and visitors to our area which is free at the point of contact.

CMR have 45 volunteers who are on call 24 hours a day every day of the year; responding to over 60 emergency call outs every year, along with mutual aid assistance where our specialist skills and equipment are needed to help people who are injured, taken ill, lost, missing or are in need of help.

The service relies wholly on charitable donations from local organisations and members of the public, along with the volunteers who give their time year-round.

Essential training of the volunteers is required and is subject to ongoing refreshment and accreditation. This funding in particular will allow CMR to carry out vital response driver training, to enable the team to safely and effectively deploy to all Call Outs.

The training will provide them with the knowledge and skills needed to drive a Team Vehicle under response conditions and an awareness of current rules and regulations and will also help cover the Team if Section 19 of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 2006 is implemented.

The ERDT Response Driver Training Course is based on individual competencies and will ensure the driver has the knowledge, understanding and skills required to driver under emergency response conditions (no exemptions). Day 1 covers advanced driving skills (theory and practical) and 4x4 vehicle stability training. Day 2 covers Emergency Response Driving (no exemptions) using visual and audible warnings equipment.

**Decision:**

To provide £3,500 funding from the Police Property Act Fund (PPAF) for Cleveland Mountain Rescue Team to be able to carry out training for 10 most used response drivers.




