Title: Show Racism the Red Card Funding			
Executive Summary: Show Racism the Red Card are a North East based charity who deliver anti racism awareness work through a sports based model utilising current and ex professional footballers. Workshops focus on delivering: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - A better understanding of racism and its impacts - An increased awareness of the responsibility to challenge racism and how this can be done - A better understanding of appropriate/inappropriate terminology in relation to race - An increased awareness of critical thinking and its usefulness in challenging stereotypes and recognising media bias <p>Reported hate crime across Cleveland has increased in the last year with a significant proportion of perpetrators being young people. The funding will allow delivery of 30 anti racism sessions in schools and youth focused establishments i.e. youth clubs, together with two football club events involving Middlesbrough FC and Hartlepool FC and local schools. Delivery will take place from September 2021 - August 2022.</p> <p>Sessions will be targeted at:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Schools where hate crime has been reported - Areas where hate crime hotspots have been noted through crime analysis - Areas where refugees and asylum seekers are being placed for the first time
