Title: Appointment of Chief Executive and Monitoring Officer

Executive Summary:

Paragraph 7 of Schedule 1 to the Police Reform and Social Responsibility Act 2011 requires the Police and Crime Commissioner (PCC) to appoint a person to act as Chief Executive where the post has become vacant. Paragraph 9 of Schedule 1 further requires the PCC to notify Police and Crime Panel Members of this proposed appointment, and in notifying the Panel of a proposed senior appointment must provide the below information:

- The name of the person being proposed to appoint to the role;
- The criteria that were used to assess the suitability of the candidate.
- Why the candidate satisfies those criteria; and
- The terms and conditions upon which the candidate is to be appointed

The report attached at Appendix A covers the above points as well as information on the appointment process that was followed.

Furthermore attached at Appendix B is the report of the panel meeting held on 12 October 2021 confirming the unanimous decision to recommend to the PCC that Mrs Oldroyd be appointed as Chief Executive and Monitoring Officer.


