Title: Community Safety Fund (CSF) Meeting – May 2022

Executive Summary:

Bid applications from within the local community are invited via the PCC's 'Apply for PCC Funding' initiative.

Applicants can apply for either the Community Safety Fund (CSF) or the Police Property Act Fund (PPAF) by submitting an application form detailing their initiative, and how that initiative fits into the PCC's funding criteria.

As we have entered a new financial year, the PCC has reviewed applications received to date and has made the decision to fund a number of initiatives within the Cleveland area, using the 2022/23 allocated budgets.

Decision:

To approve funding to the following successful bid applicants: -

Saltburn Athletic Football Club - £7,244.00

To purchase additional kit and equipment to support and enhance the overall service provided at Saltburn Athletic targeting youths aged between 8 and 17-year-old.

Stockton All girls Rugby - £600.00

Funding to be used towards a women's and girls' festival of rugby in September 2022. This will see junior girls' teams aged 12-18 years from throughout the North East attending to play a series of games prompting the game amongst women and girls.

Eid Fusion Festival 2022 - £500.00

Funding will be used to hire a Health bus to attend the 2022 Eid Fusion Festival in Ropner park (July 2022) in line with this year's festival theme 'Health & Wellbeing'.

Coastwatch Redcar - £1,980.00

This charity aids the protection and preservation of life at sea along the North Yorkshire coast between Hartlepool, the River Tees and Saltburn. Funding will be used to enable the purchase of a new safety ladder.

Justice First - £1,500.00

This funding will assist towards the delivery of a one-day, multi-cultural football tournament, enabling local emergency service providers, and representatives from local Health Services, the opportunity to highlight their facilities, whilst interacting with various refugee and asylum-seeking groups.
